That each school day, 46 children are diagnosed with cancer. That is 2 classrooms full of children.

Although long-term survival rates are steadily increasing, one quarter of children will die within 5 years of their cancer diagnosis.

Currently, one in every 330 children in the United States develops cancer before the age of nineteen.

By the year 2010, 1 in 250 young adults will be a childhood cancer survivor.

Most childhood cancer survivors live the remainder of their lives with secondary effects of cancer treatment.

100% of children experience stress and anxiety at the time of diagnosis.
